British Schools Programme Equivalency G.C.E, I.G.C.S.E, G.C.S.E 2019/2020

The requirements for AI Tawjihi equivalency:

- 12 years of studies as a regular school student, and 13 years of school years.
- At least the student has been in the same programme for the last three years.
- Six O-levels and/or IGCSE/GCSE subjects from A* to D or (9-4).
- Two A-level subjects from A* to E.
- Arabic language (First Language) is mandatory at either the Ordinary or Advanced levels for Arab students in Arab countries, (ARABIC CLASSICAL FIRST LANGUAGE, ARABIC 3180, ARABIC 4AA).
- Same subject in two levels is considered as two separate subjects.
- Must pass the national subjects in grades 11 and 12 of Arabic (Communications Skills), Islamic studies (for Muslim students) and Jordan History, in addition to British General Culture Subjects.
- Certified copies of the last three scholastic years (10th, 11th and 12th certificates) for students from outside Jordan for (A- Level), (AS), and (O-Level) certified by the British Council Jordan.
- All certificates must be certified by the British Council Jordan.
- Computing, Computer Studies and Information Technology are considered science and Literary subjects at the Ordinary level and Advanced level.

Scientific stream equivalency:

- Six passes in IGCSE or O-level exams including:
 - Two passes in science subjects.
 - One pass in Arabic (first language).
- Two passes in A level:
 - One full A level in Physics or in Mathematics.
 - The other A level may be an A level in any science or two AS's in two sciences.

Literary stream equivalency:

- Six passes in IGCSE or O-level exams including:
 - Any two science subjects.
- Two passes in A-level:
 - One full A level must be in Arabic.
 - The other A level can be one of the following options:
 - Full A level in any literary subject.
 - Two AS's in any two literary subjects.
 - One AS in a literary subject and one AS in a scientific subject.
- Required Documents:
 - Certified copies of the last three scholastic years (10th, 11th and 12th certificates).
 - Copies of (A- Level), (AS), and (O- Level) certified by the British Council Jordan.
 - Identity proof for student and applicant.
 - Document of equivalency request for non-Jordanian students.
- Final grade is calculated based on below formula and according to average of the eight subjects:

 <u>All Applicable from this year for 12 grade graduate students of 2019/2020</u> <u>School year.</u>

Note:

Student can choose to take one additional (A Level) to raise their grade by choosing for it to be fully counted in the equivalent or a part of it as well, as long as students' grade would not exceed 100%.
